





# SHOWBUS flyby

## WELCOME TO SHOWBUS

I set up the Brunel Bus Society as a means of getting some extra money out of the Students Union. There were countless left wing societies with twenty signatures – often the same twenty – who could wangle £100, which seemed to be the going rate. I had been involved with the University’s Physics Society and it had a huge membership, despite physics being amongst the smallest departments, but we staged events with a broad appeal, but came in for criticism when we ran a trip to the seaside as an opportunity to witness the moon’s gravitational effect on the ocean.

Getting twenty Physics Society members to sign up to join the Bus Society was easy. Joint society ventures were encouraged so a joint trip to the seaside with the Physics Society was not a problem and I chose one of London Country’s Alexander bodied AEC Swifts (SMA) for the trip.

that we had to find a bigger venue. Eventually we settled at Woburn Abbey in 1982 until ten years later when widespread flooding in Bedfordshire nearly caused the event to be cancelled at the last minute. So Showbus almost came to an end after twenty years but for the intervention of three then young enthusiastic helpers, Rob Passaway, Dave Reid and Charlie Nicholson who instigated the change of venue to Duxford Air Museum where the event blossomed. With the global recession the finances no longer added up, we were running at a loss by 2014 and eventually settled on a good venue at Donington Park for three years, until they too wanted to charge more for their venue than the income could support. So we end our run at the vast Hertfordshire County Showground, hopefully this year accommodating more buses than ever before at the site.

Then along came the annual university community festival, Brunelzeebub and I was asked what the Bus Society was going to do. So in the middle of January 1973 we stage a bus rally. We paid the London Bus Preservation Group (now at Brooklands) £5 for each of the four buses they brought along and amazingly nearly twenty buses turned up, including one of London Country’s first Leyland Nationals and the Wings Tour Bus.

That’s where it all started. The rest as they say is history. The planned Brunelzeebus 74 was moved – thanks to the miners strike - to the Hillingdon Show in June as SHOWBUS 74. It grew there under National Express sponsorship to the extent

Preparing the brochure for this final SHOWBUS has been a trip down memory lane. I am grateful to Gary Seamarks for many of the photos illustrating National Express coaches, Ensignbus and Leyland Nationals at SHOWBUS over the last fifty years as all three join us in celebrating their half centuries. I was surprised at how many entrants, some quite notable, over the years I had forgotten. It was sobering to reflect on the many amazing exhibits there have been. The first bendibus, a fuel cell Citaro, RMF1254, a Standerwick Bristol VRLH, Barton’s lowheight Loline, a Bristol RE from New Zealand and an Atlantean from Australia. Stevensons, South Midland, Kentish bus, Swindon Corporation, Halton Transport, Southend Transport, Midland Red, Stratford Blue, North Western, Derby, Maidstone & District, East Kent, Royal Blue, Devon General, United Counties, Ribble, Red Rover, Westcliff-on-Sea, OK Travel, Thames Valley, Alder Valley, Southdown, Eastern Scottish, Northern Scottish, AA and A1 from Scotland and many more. It also emphasised the changes the bus industry has gone through over the years with London Country and Alder Valley showing off their new poppy red and leaf green colours in 1973 through the kaleidoscope of colours as the industry deregulated. Gary has produced an excellent book illustrating "SHOWBUS the Woburn and Duxford Years" and has kindly taken over the job as Official Photographer from Chris Strong who was torn this year between attending SHOWBUS or his wife's 40<sup>th</sup> birthday, he chose the latter even though we are ten years older.

Usually at this point I wish you an enjoyable visit and look forward to seeing you next year. Fortunately this is not the complete end for SHOWBUS, the SHOWBUSflyby, born out of the pandemic in 2020 will continue for a few more years. The date has been set for September 12<sup>th</sup> and it will again centre on High Wycombe, where the Traders Village will operate. As I discovered the SHOWBUSflyby can be organised from an armchair whereas the physical work in staging a huge display is reaching a point where it will soon no longer be possible, which is why it has to come to an end.

 1982 Moved to Woburn Abbey  
 1992 Almost cancelled due to widespread flooding in Bedfordshire  
 1993 Moved to Duxford  
 2000 Millennium SHOWBUS attracts 4 buses from Holland amidst record entry  
 2001 National fuel strike blights entries  
 2002 Golden Jubilee with Gold Run and display of Gold Buses, entries hit 400+  
 2012 Diamond Jubilee display  
 2013 Moved to Stratford-upon-Avon  
 2014 Final Duxford rally. RM 60th  
 2015 Return to Woburn Abbey  
 2016 Moved to Donington Park  
 2019 Moved to Herts Showground though the sun shone entries were blighted by an doomsday forecast  
 2020 Pandemic forces change to flyby  
 2021 Fuel shortages affect entries, Event nearly cancelled by Graham McMillan COVID supremo at Herts County Council who wanted a 20 page form completed 2 days beforehand—probably the same guy who wanted Jubilee street party planners to include plans in case of a terrorist attack.




